


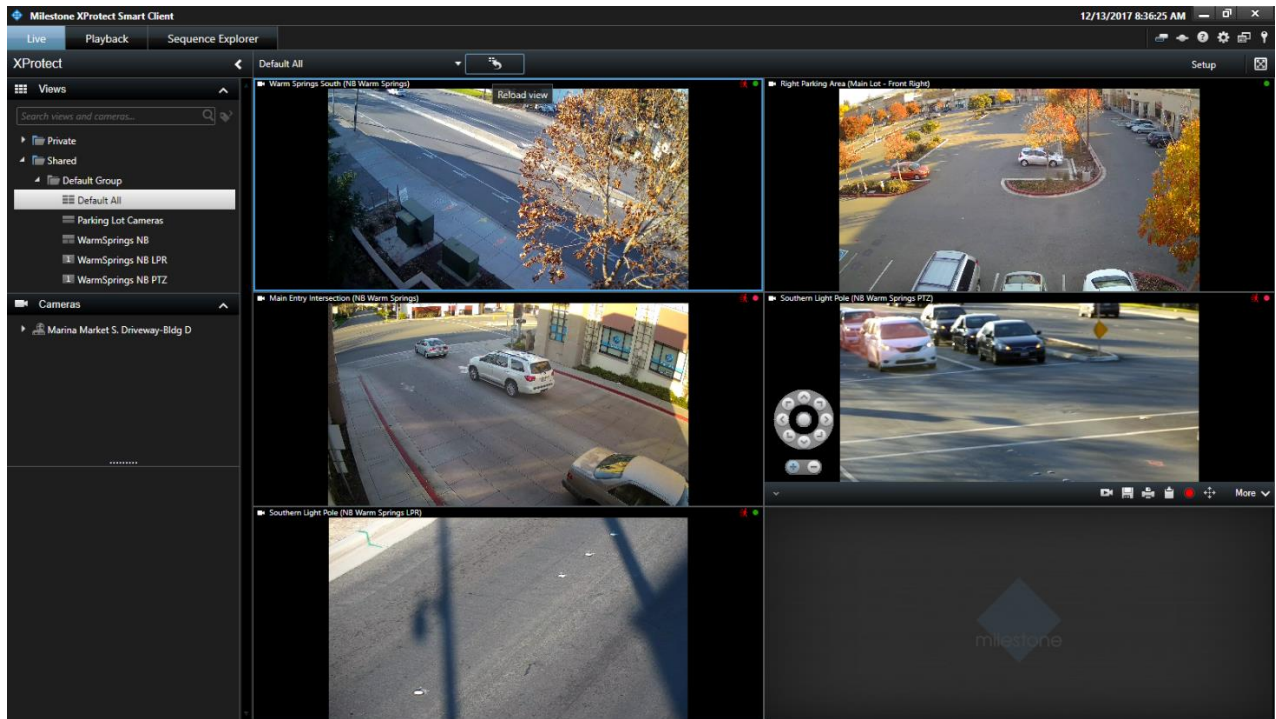
Launch XProtect Smart Client



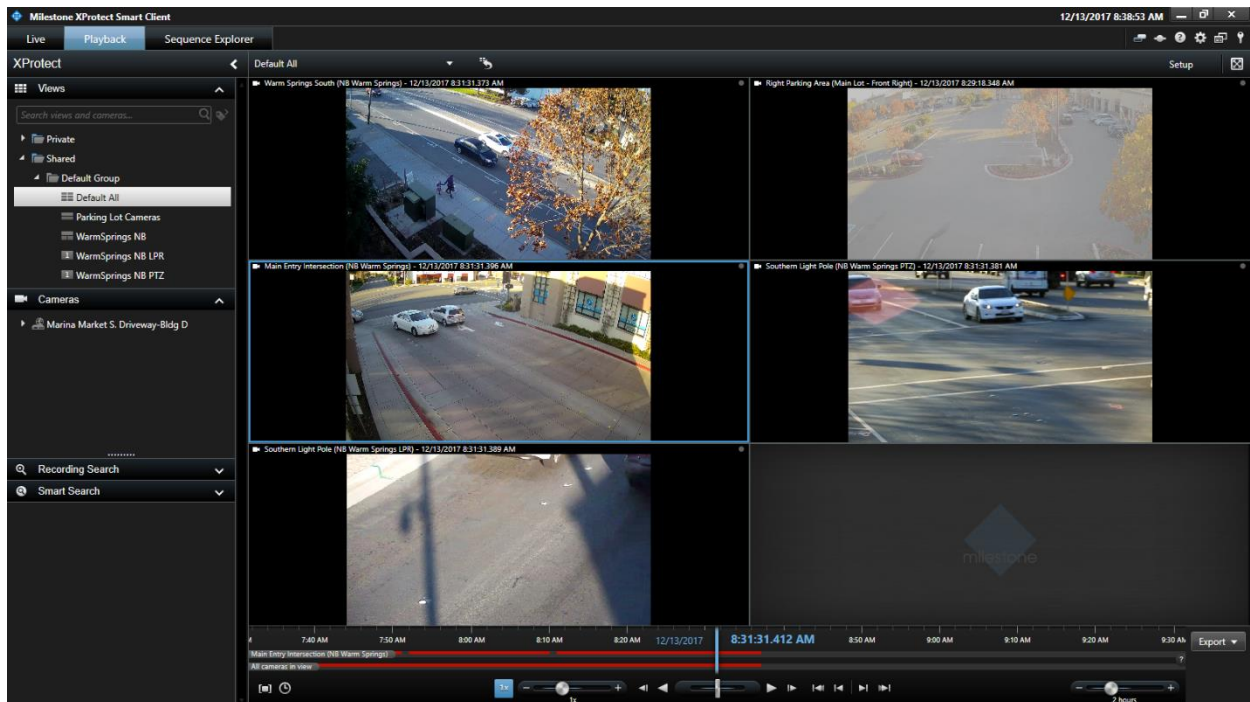

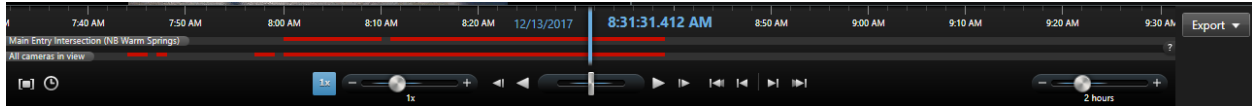
- Computer – IP address of the milestone server

The system may log you into Live mode or Playback, this is the live view

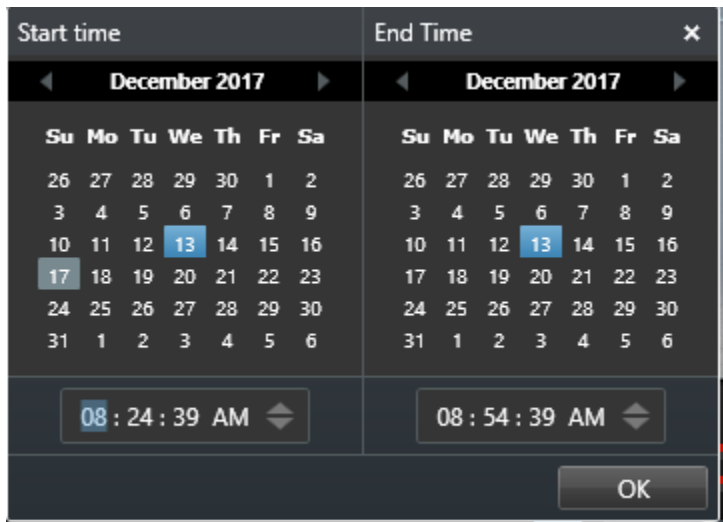


This is the playback view. The red bar at the bottom shows where there is video. Gaps in the bar show where there are gaps in playback for the camera that is selected (the camera with a blue box around it). Playback will typically start from the last video recorded.



Starting from the left, the first icon is Time Selection Mode, you can use this to manually select start and end times that you want to review. When you select it, a bracket [] will appear on the timeline, which can be expanded and contracted to the times you want. Useful if you already near the footage you want to review.

The next icon is Set Start/End Time. This gives you a pop up calendar that can be to easily jump to a time frame in the past.



After clicking "OK" it will jump to the date and time specified and will enable the Time Selection Mode option, so you can expand or trim your window if necessary.

The next option is playback speed, the bar will let you speed up and slow down the playback speed, the 1x will quickly change it back to 1x playback if you need to.

Next is the playback controls. First will skip backward by a single frame each time it is clicked, then you have reverse playback, it will playback at whatever speed was selected in the controls to the left. The bar in the middle can be dragged in either direction to playback in the selected direction. Playback speed depends on how far to the right or left it is dragged. Next is forward playback, it will playback at the speed selected on the controls to the left. Next is the skip forward option, this one jumps a single frame forward.

The next group of controls are for bigger jumps. The first option, is to jump to the oldest recording. Next is the option to jump to the next oldest recording from where playback currently is. After that is the option to jump to the next recording in the timeline. Finally, is the option to jump to the newest recording. This group of controls is based on the camera that is selected. A blue box will highlight whichever camera is selected. The name of the camera should also be shown at the beginning of the red bar as shown above.

The last bar at the bottom right lets you select how large of a window you are viewing so you can move around more easily. It can be as small as a 5-minute interval or up to 4 weeks.

Another way to jump to different points in the playback is the blue time indicator in the middle of the playback bar. Click this and it will give you a calendar like the one shown above to quickly jump to a date and time. This option does not turn on the Time Selection mode like the option previously mentioned.

This walkthrough is based on XProtect Smart Client 2017 R2. If you are using a different version it will look somewhat different, but should have the same options. The Smart Client Program is a free download from the milestonesys.com website. You can download the latest version even if it is a newer version than what you have, as long as you download the version labeled "For Express and Professional". If it doesn't say that then it will not work.

If you need help exporting video as well, please let us know and we can work on a walkthrough for that. To do that one we would either need to know the version of smart client on your computer, or you will want to update to the latest version.
